Apprentice Powerline Worker Certificate III – ESI Distribution (Powerline)

Background

The Powerline Worker Apprenticeship will be conducted over a four year period incorporating both formal training (attendance at TAFE) and "in field" (on the job) segments.

A career as a Powerline Worker will see you responsible for constructing and maintaining overhead and underground electrical lines and structures. You must be willing to work outdoors on ladders and elevated work platforms and in all weather conditions.
